# WHAT YOU NEED TO DO

*In an essay, discuss a social cause that you are passionate about. Please share what inspired you to learn about the cause, and share at least one way you have, or would like to work towards the resolution of the social issue.*

## Essay Criteria

- 800-1000 word limit
- 12-point font size, double-spaced
- Cite any external source using any style you are familiar with (APA, MLA, Chicago...etc.)
- Essays will be assessed on the following categories:
  - **Writing Mechanics** – Grammar and punctuation
  - **Organization** – The flow and progression of the essay
  - **Essay Prompt** – How the prompt is addressed and focused on
  - **Content** – Having a clear thesis with supporting material
  - **Critical Thinking** – The display of independent ideas and critical thought processes
